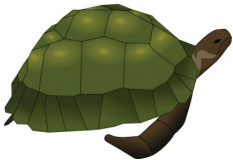
Mammals

Tuesday

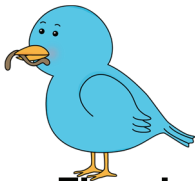
Reptiles

Wednesday

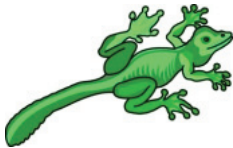
Birds
