To receive your discounted school group admission rate. Reservations must be received, in writing or online, at least two (2) weeks in advance. The discount on regular priced admission will apply for a group of 20 or more paying people. All school groups / home school groups with children under the age of 13 must have adult supervision with a ratio of one adult for every 10 children.

Reservation requests: To request a reservation time for your school group, schedule your trip under the PLAN YOUR VISIT section online at montgomeryzoo.com, or submit the School Group Reservation form by mail or email to zooinfo@ montgomeryal.gov. Do not send money with the request form. Payment is due at the time of your group's arrival at the Zoo's admission window. The group must enter the Zoo admission gate together and one person must pay for the entire group. Extra adults, chaperones and/or paying individuals (all individuals not included on your group reservation totals) will be charged full admission prices. A Reservation Confirmation will be sent to you confirming either your first or second choice. Based on availability, one of the dates you selected will be assigned by Zoo or Museum personnel.

Parents, chaperones, friends and family members not included in the group reservation will have to pay regular admission rather than the discounted rate. In order for parents, chaperones, friends, family members to receive the discounted admission rate, they MUST BE INCLUDED in the group reservation and payment.

Payment: Admission, rides, encounters, attractions, and Overlook Café food purchases are required to be combined into one payment. Payment can be cash (on-site only), credit card, check, or purchase order. Checks should be written to the MONTGOMERY ZOO.

Confirmations: If you do not receive your school group reservation confirmation within 72 hours after submission, please contact the Zoo at (334) 625-4905. Your reservation form may have been lost / delayed in transmission via FAX or email.

Get wristbands and ride tickets early / avoid the wait when checking in at the Zoo: Group leaders may pay for and pick up wristbands and/or attraction ride tickets prior to their group's scheduled visit date. Pay with a credit card while making online reservations or pay at the Museum (by appointment) prior to the group's scheduled visit date. Also, if you live a distance from the Zoo, we can mail your wristbands and tickets certified USPS mail for an additional fee of \$20 per order. Then on the scheduled visit date, you and your group can bypass the lines waiting for wristbands and tickets and walk directly into the Zoo. To arrange any of these payment options, please call (334) 625-4905.

Cancellation Policy: Call the Zoo/Museum office at (334) 625-4905 prior to the date of your visit to cancel or change your reservations. Failure to cancel your reservations with adequate notice will make you liable for the cost of program fees, tour fees, shelter rentals and/or food items ordered, etc. You may cancel your group meals up to 24 hours before scheduled arrival to the Zoo/Museum. Any cancellations made within the 24 hour window will be charged in full for your group meals unless the cancellation is due to a weather related event.

Picnics and outside food: Picnics and outside food are allowed in all areas of the Zoo with the exception of the Overlook. Guests and visitors may have picnic lunches and snacks at the various shelters, grassy areas, benches, tent areas and the playground area. No cup lids and/or straws will be allowed for the protection of our animals. We do ask all of your guests to clean up their picnic areas when you are done to keep our Zoo as clean as you found it.

Shelter rentals: Shelters are available for rental. Make your reservations online at montgomeryzoo.com or contact the Zoo directly. Playground area: \$65 for three hours. Front gate area: \$65 for three hours. Time slots available for both: 9am - noon and 1pm -4pm. Shelters must be reserved in advance.

Concessions: Zoo and Museum Gift shops. A variety of snacks, candy, sodas, and water are available at the at both gift shops. Overlook Cafe. A variety of snacks, refreshments, drinks, meals, slushies, ice cream, and much more are available at the Overlook Cafe. No food or drinks allowed in the Mann Museum.

Zoo Wildlife Adventures, Rides, and Encounters.

Train: The Montgomery Zoo's miniature train runs daily, 9am - 4pm. Tickets are \$3 per person. Giraffe Encounter Post: Open daily, check montgomeryzoo.com for hours. Tickets are \$3 per person. Zoofari Skylift Rides: Open daily, 10am - 4pm. Tickets are \$5. All riders must be at least 32 inches tall. Waters of the World: Open daily, check montgomeryzoo.com for hours. Entry FREE. Located adjacent to Mann Museum. Parakeet Cove Feed Sticks: Cove open daily, check montgomeryzoo.com for hours, Feeding sticks are \$2 per stick.
